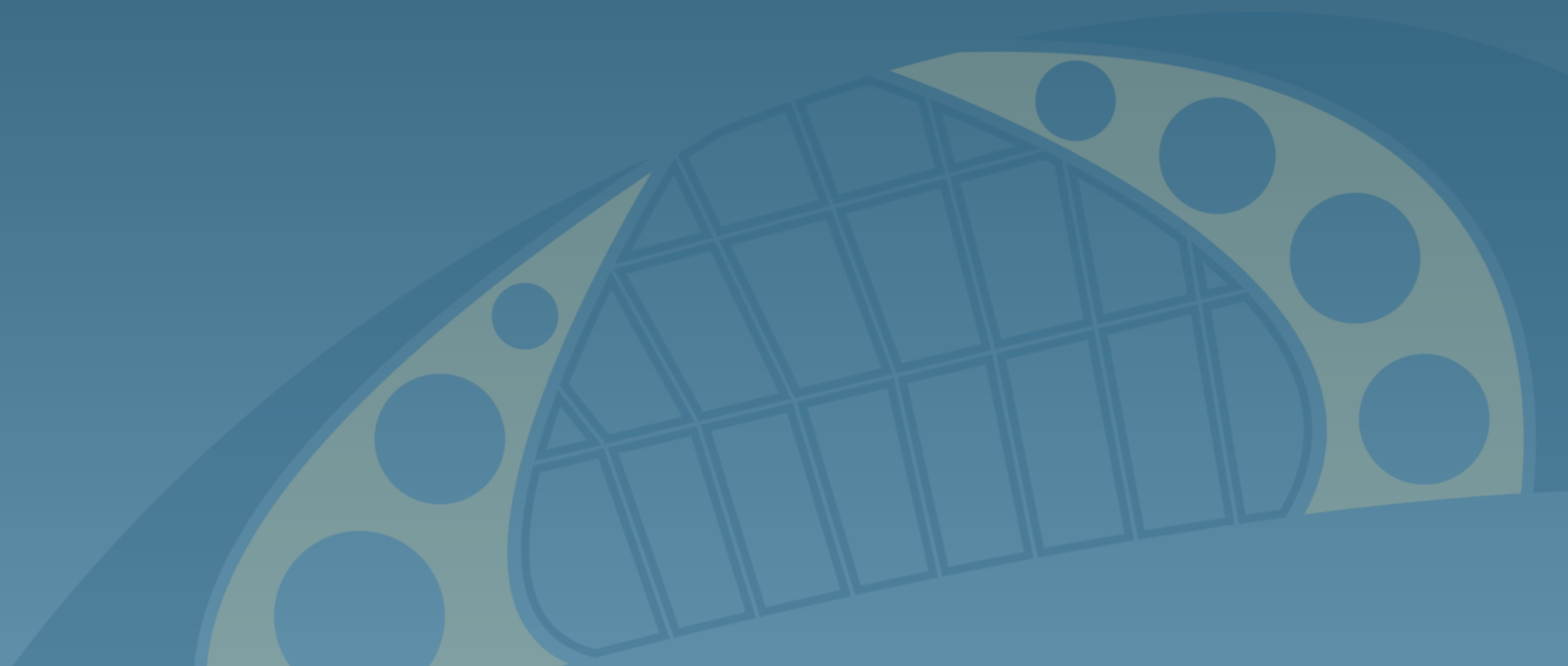

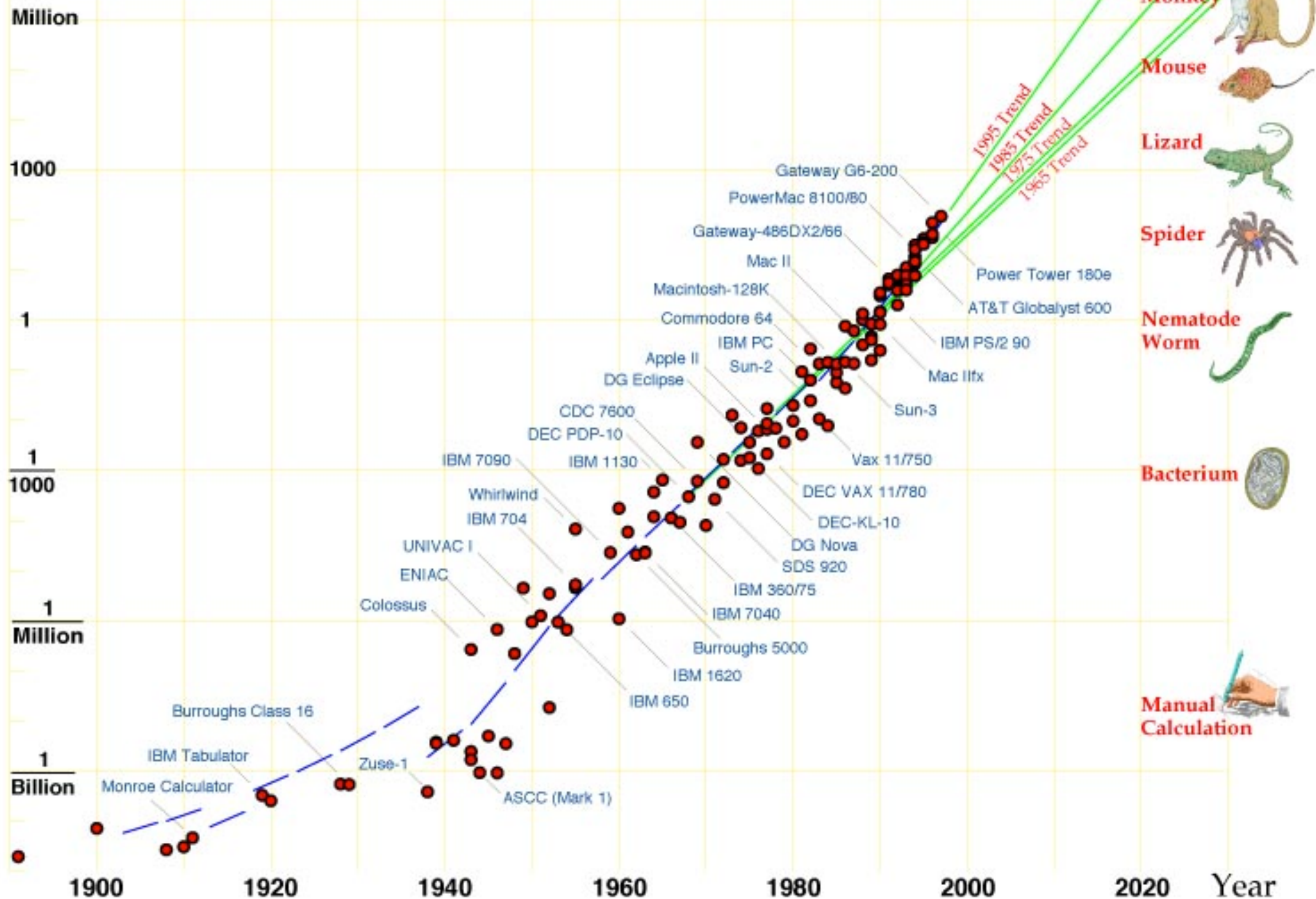

Evolution of Computer Power/Cost

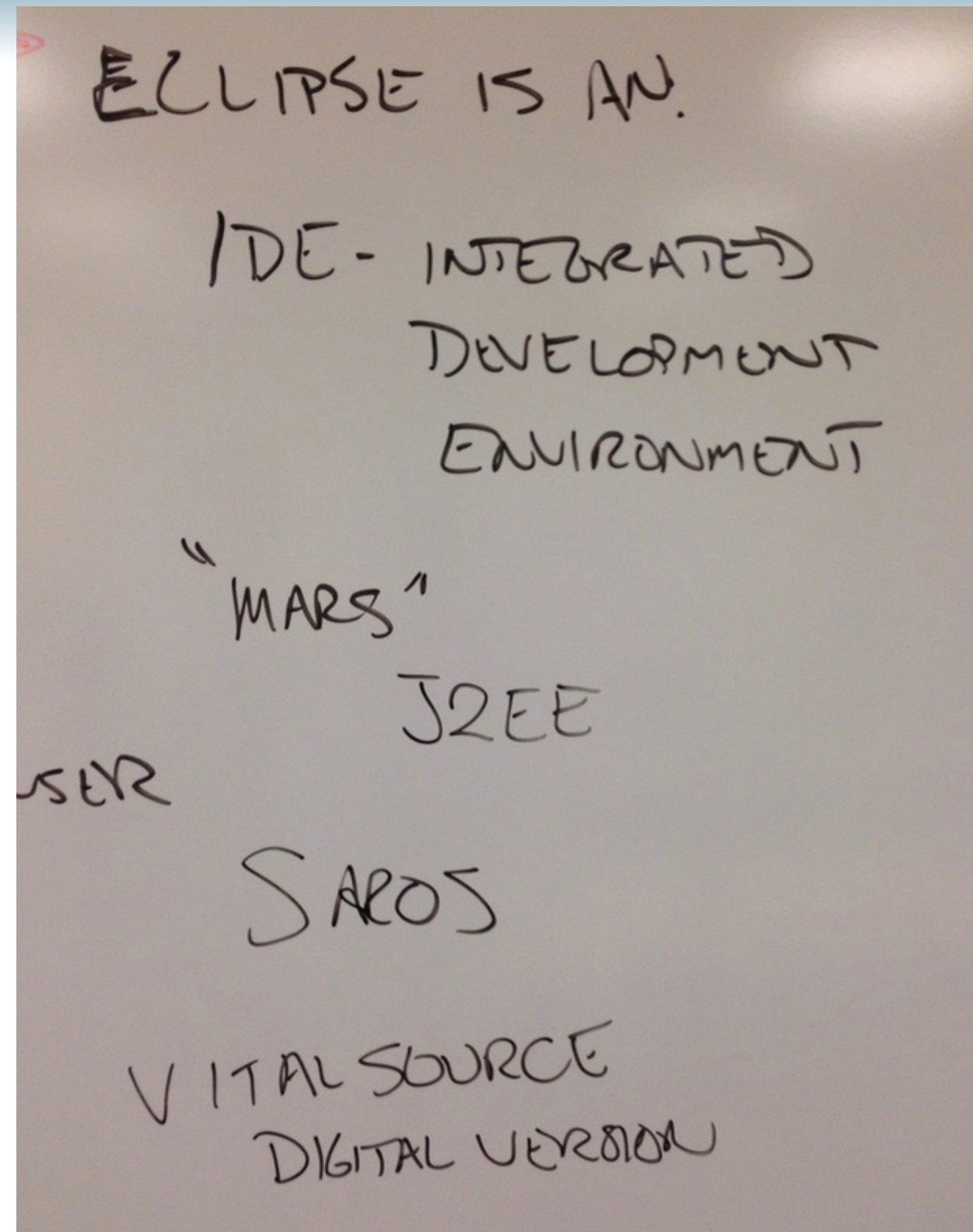
Brain Power Equivalent per \$1000 of Computer

MIPS per \$1000 (1997 Dollars)



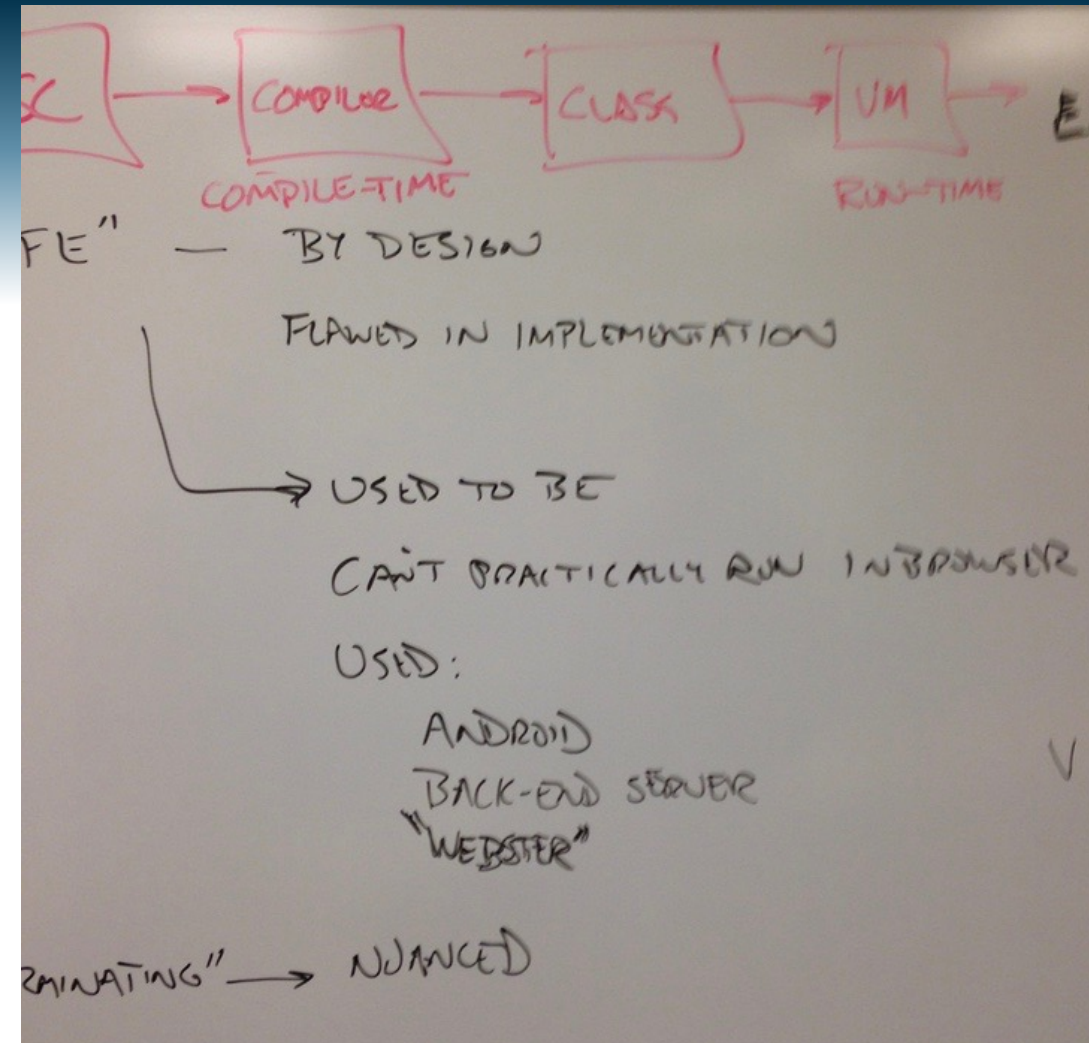
BOARD NOTES

- Eclipse
 - Current version is "Mars"
 - Saros is a real-time collaborative editor for Eclipse - completely optional
- VitalSource
 - online viewer for textbook.
I'm not sure how you get the code to download it



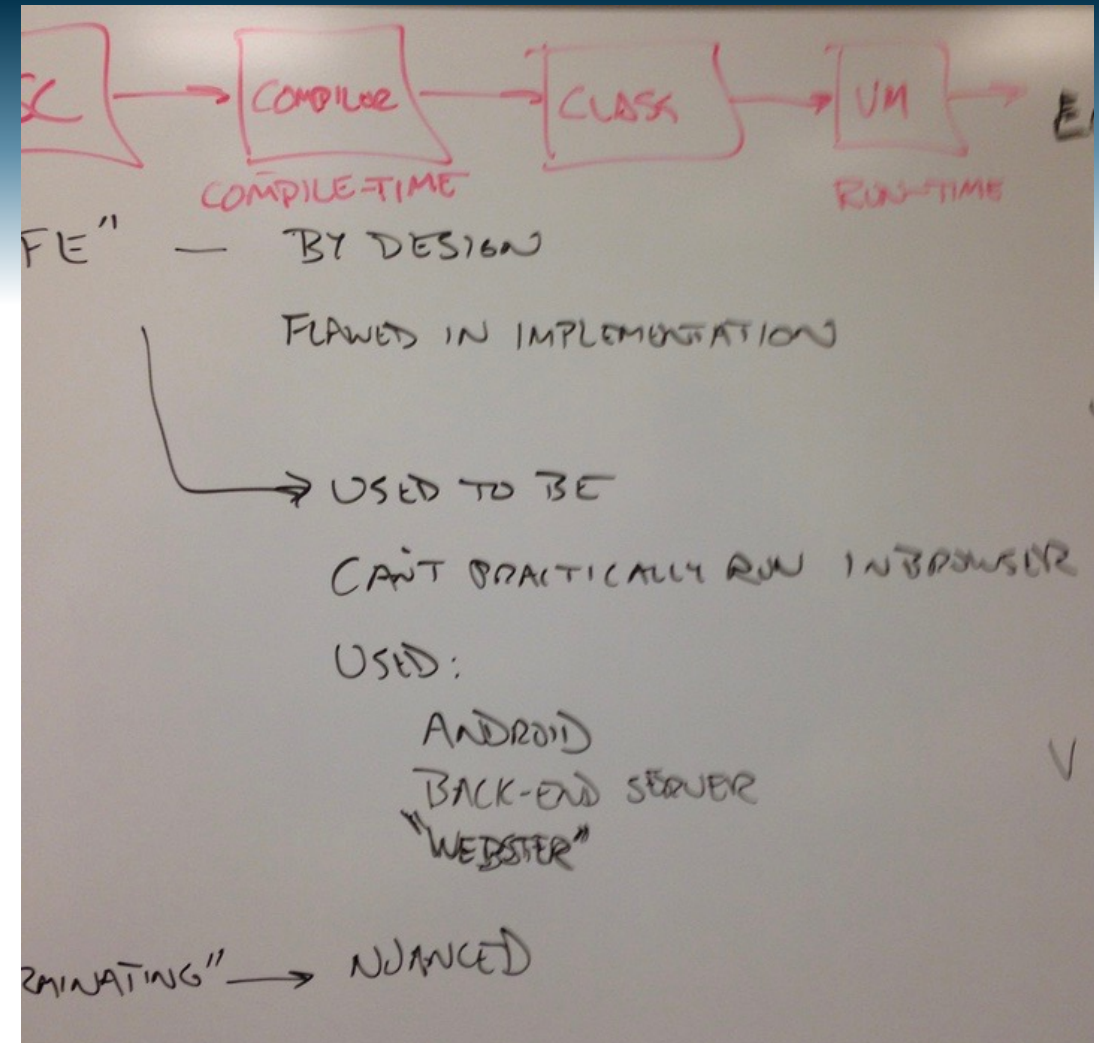
BOARD NOTES

- Compile-Time Errors
 - Detected in Eclipse
 - Occur primarily from syntax errors
- Run-time Errors
 - Occur from logic errors
 - “Unit testing” is a strategy for catching these



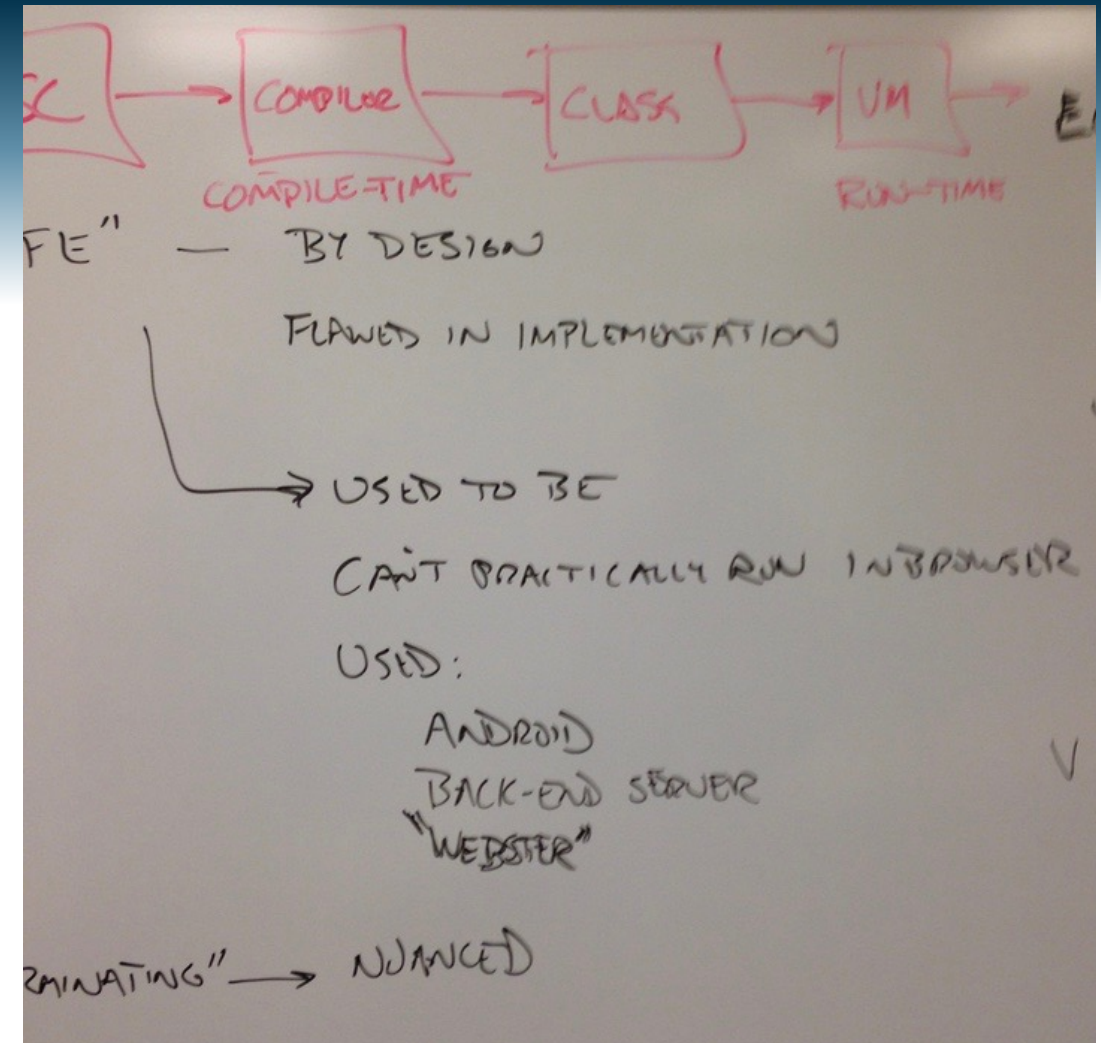
BOARD NOTES

- Java is “Safe”
 - Designed to be safe
 - In practice not implemented very safely
- Java is not used much for front-end development - mostly servers and Android now



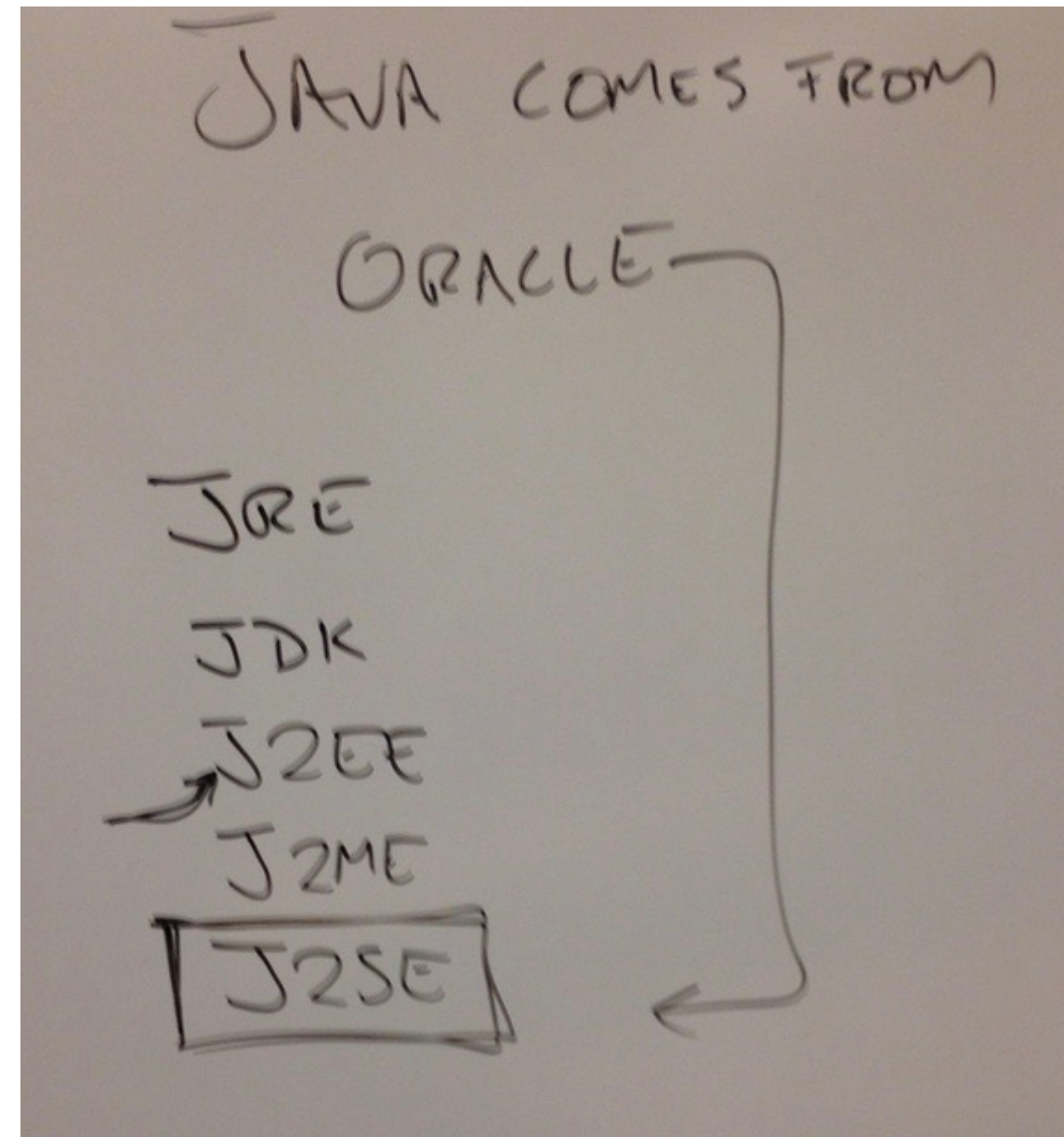
BOARD NOTES

- An algorithm is “terminating”
 - This is nuanced. There are plenty of algorithms that don’t terminate that are legitimate algorithms.
- For a basic understanding assume algorithms must terminate.



BOARD NOTES

- Java downloads
 - JRE - Runtime Environment
 - so you can run Java programs
 - the virtual machine
 - JDK - Development Kit
- Java Editions
 - J2EE - Enterprise Edition
 - J2SE - Standard Edition
 - J2ME - Micro Edition
- You need a JDK to program java programs -
